We are seeking abstracts that highlight and advance the field of cancer. We welcome all areas of research within the basic, clinical and population-based cancer research fields. Research areas of priority include (but not limited to):

- Molecular cancer mechanisms (e.g., cellular signaling)
- Genetic approaches in cancer research (e.g.; epigenetics, genomics)
- Bioinformatics, biostatistical, and epidemiological approaches to address cancer
- Racial and/or immigrant cancer health disparities
- Early detection/screening tools and measures (e.g., biomarkers, population-based screening)
- Novel treatment programs and interventions to treat cancer (e.g., cancer immunotherapy, clinical trials)
- Disparities in cancer clinical trial participation
- Social determinants of health, behavioral and community-based participatory research
- Population-based cancer prevention programs (e.g., health education, social media campaigns)
